





National filings by geographical area


EPO - OBI collaboration agreement

IP Academy

- Signed in 2012
- Effective co-operation between the EPO and HIPO with the objective to promote access to patents in some countries where users are facing financial difficulties.
- Reduction of search price for specific categories of applicants: SMEs, universities, research institutes and natural persons.
- Financial support (reduction granted) increased from 50% to 75% in 2016.
- Other conditions: reduction available only for national first filings from SMEs etc.; maximum of 100 dossiers per year per country.
- Countries: Greece, Cyprus, Lithuania, Turkey, Malta.
- EPO search reports with written opinion during the past 5 years (2012 2016): 142
